# WHAT TO BRING

## **BABIES & PRESCHOOL LEARN TO SWIM**

- Aqua nappies for any children not toilet trained please ensure they are tight fitting around the thighs. We recommend aqua nappies for any children under 3.
- Aqua nappies can also be purchased at Oasis reception

# **LEARN TO SWIM & SQUADS**

- Appropriate swimwear, racer style for girls and briefs or shorts for boys
- Swimming cap
- Googles
- Long hair tied back out of eyes preferred

# PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

- Photographs are permitted within public areas of pool deck and limited to your own child.
- Parents permission will be required for any group photos
- Centre's policy can be provided on request



## **MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION**

#### **PAYMENT OF LESSONS**

Lessons are offered as part of a Swim School membership and payments are made on a fortnightly basis via direct debit

#### **MEMBERSHIP ENTITLEMENTS**

 Active membership holders are entitled to free entry into the pool outside of lesson times

 Membership includes entry of two additional persons when accompanied with a swim school student with active membership

 Membership does not cover entry for external user groups, programs or water play activities such as Swimming Club, In-Term Swimming and VACswim program



# **MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION**

#### **MEMBERSHIP SUSPENSION**

Memberships may be suspended for a minimum of 1 week and a maximum of 4 weeks

A hold fee of \$5.50 applies for each week per child Suspension forms are available at reception and are required to be submitted I week prior to the direct debit period in order to be applied

#### **MISSED LESSONS**

No refunds or make up lessons are available

# **CANCELLATION OF MEMBERSHIP**

- Cancellation requests must be submitted in writing, Cancellation/suspension requests won't be accepted over the phone or via sms or social media channels
- A notice period of 4 lessons applies to all cancellation requests.
- Any notice periods commence from the date the cancellation form is received from Oasis reception.
- Cancellation forms are available at Oasis reception.

# PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The safety of all our patrons and members is really important to us, especially near the water.

By all working together we can help ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable time in the pools.

### **ENTRY & SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS**

- Children under the age of 12 years are required to be accompanied onto pool deck and actively supervised by an 18+ adult.
- Parent to be in pool for lesson with any children under 3
- Children under the age of 6 must be within arms reach of parent or caregiver and directly supervised at all times
- Parent/caregivers are required to remain on pool deck for the duration of the child/children's lessons.
- Parent/caregivers are responsible for attending to their child/children's needs bathroom, goggles etc
- At completion of lessons students need to safely exit the pool and must go directly to their parent or caregiver for direct supervision

# EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURES

- In the event of an emergency evacuation the Instructor will escort the entire class to the designated muster point.
- Parent/caregiver may accompany the student to the designated muster point.
- A child may only be released from the Instructor's care once advised that it is safe to do so by the Team Leader or PDS.



# STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

- Students must walk on pool deck
- Only enter the pool when instructed to do so by an Oasis Swim School Instructor.
- Wear appropriate attire including goggles and a swimming cap.
- Always listen to the direction of Oasis Swim School Instructors and Supervisors.
- Treat other students, staff and members of the community with respect, courtesy and without discrimination.
- Be respectful to all equipment and facilities within the Oasis.
- Obey all aquatic area rules.
- No talking or disruptive behaviour when the teacher is instructing.
- Keep heads above water unless directed as part of lesson.
- Keep boards above water unless directed as part of lesson.
- Be safe, have fun and always try your best!



# PARENT/CAREGIVER CODE OF CONDUCT

- Treat other students, Goldfields Oasis staff and members of the community with respect, courtesy and without discrimination.
- Always celebrate your child's achievements rather than focus on their mistakes.
- Direct any enquiries to the Swim School Team Leader or Pool Deck Supervisor. Please refrain from direct interaction with Swim School Instructors during lesson times.
- Please support Instructors by monitoring your child's behaviour and ensuring they are giving their best to the Instructor and the other students.
- Encourage children to participate to the best of their ability.
- Assist or escort children who require a bathroom break.
- Respect the conditions of entry and any decisions made by Goldfields Oasis staff.







#### STEP THREE

- Follow the additional steps to set up your swim school enrolment




